Floor Cleaning


For low-soiled surfaces like floors & large open areas: Dose 50 to 75 ml of P8 into water and mix well. Dip & squeeze the mop before cleaning floors for excellent results. For effective germ kill all surfaces must remain wet for at-least 15 mins

For moderately soiled surfaces like kitchen & bathroom floors, etc.: Dose 150 to 175 ml of P8 into water and mix well. Dip & squeeze the mop before cleaning floors for excellent results. For effective germ kill all surfaces must remain wet for at-least 10-15 mins

Glass Cleaning

Simply spray on any glass surface and wipe off after 30 seconds using a clean damp cloth.

Small Surfaces

For Cleaning/Degreasing Small Surfaces such as bathroom fixtures, counter-tops, etc.: Mix 150 ml of product in 350 ml of water. Fill the prepared solution in a trigger spray bottle. Spray on the surface & wipe. For effective germ kill all surfaces must remain wet for 5-10 mins.

Removal of Oil & Grease Stains

For heavy-soiled/light grease/high-contact surfaces like kitchen platforms, doorknobs, handles, railings, elevator buttons, etc.: Apply undiluted. Spray surface until thoroughly wet. Leave for 5-10 seconds. Wipe or Rinse **gently** with a clean cloth or sponge. Allow product to sit to penetrate soil before wiping clean. Repeat if necessary.
To sanitize: Leave for 10 seconds before wiping.
To disinfect: Leave for 30 seconds before wiping.
For food preparation areas rinse the surfaces before use.

For older, dried oil stains, you might need to pre-treat the area by applying **undiluted P8** to the stained surface until thoroughly wet and let it sit for a longer period, possibly 10-15 minutes. Use a soft-bristled brush or sponge to **gently** scrub the area. Rinse and Wipe: Rinse the area with a little water if necessary, then wipe it dry. Repeat, if necessary.

Multiple Applications: Stubborn oil stains might require several applications of the cleaner
