

Instructions for Use Pulfresh P7 Tiles Cleaner



Versatile Application

Safe to use on a variety of tile types including ceramic, porcelain, marble, and mosaic tiles without causing damage.

How to use

For Regular Cleaning

In a bucket, mix 2 capful (approximately 60ml) of P7 Pulfresh Tiles Cleaner with 1 liter of warm water. This dilution is effective for light stains and regular cleaning.

Application:

Apply the Cleaner:

Dip a mop or sponge into the diluted solution.

Wring out excess liquid to avoid oversaturating the tiles.

Start applying the cleaner to the stained areas, working in small sections.

Scrub Lightly:

Gently scrub the stained areas with the mop or sponge using circular motions. Focus on areas with visible light stains or dirt.

For textured tiles or grout lines, you may want to use a soft brush or toothbrush for better penetration.

Let It Sit (Optional):

If the stains are slightly stubborn, allow the cleaner to sit on the surface for 5-7 minutes to penetrate the dirt before scrubbing again.

Rinse the Surface:

After scrubbing, rinse the tiles with clean water to remove any remaining cleaner and loosened dirt.

You can use a clean mop or cloth dampened with plain water for this step.

Dry the Tiles:

Use a soft cloth or towel to wipe down the tiles and remove any excess water.

Drying helps prevent streaks and water spots, leaving the tiles looking clean and shiny.

Final Check:

Inspect the Area: After cleaning, check to ensure that all light stains have been removed.

If any stains remain, repeat the process as necessary.

For Hard Stains

For tougher stains, it's often effective to use P7 Pulfresh undiluted. However, if you prefer to dilute, mix 3 capful (approximately 100ml) of P7 with 500ml of warm water.

Application:

1. Apply the Cleaner:

- If using undiluted cleaner, apply it directly onto the stained areas using a sponge or spray bottle.
- For diluted cleaner, dip the scrub brush or sponge into the solution, or spray it onto the affected areas.

2. Scrub the Surface:

- Use a scrub brush or sponge to scrub the area gently but firmly, focusing on the hard water stains and soap scum.
- For grout lines and textured surfaces, an old toothbrush or a dedicated grout brush can be effective.

3. Let It Sit:

- Allow the cleaner to sit on the stains for 10-15 minutes. This will help break down tough residues and make scrubbing easier.

Rinse:

1. Rinse with Clean Water:

- After scrubbing, rinse the tiles thoroughly with clean water to remove any remaining cleaner and dislodged stains.
- Use a mop or cloth dampened with clean water for this purpose.

Drying:

1. Dry the Surface:

- Wipe the tiles dry with a soft cloth or towel to prevent water spots and streaks from forming.
- Ensure all areas are completely dry for a polished finish.

Final Check:

- **Inspect the Area:** After cleaning, check for any remaining hard water stains or soap scum. If any residues persist, repeat the cleaning process as needed.

Test on a Small Area: If you are unsure how your tiles will react, test the cleaner on a small, inconspicuous area before full application.
